He has been Director of the *Cuadernos Hispanoamericanos*. He has published extensively on the history and the memory of Flamenco. He is the author of *Blanco Spirituals* and *Las rubáiyátas de Horacio Martín*. His latest work is *La balada del abuelo Palancas*.
