

## QQHI English Language and Linguistics (2010-11 entry onwards)

NB: The second and final year requirements are identical for 2008-09 and 2009-10 entry, which had different first year compulsory modules.

### Programme structure(s) and requirements, levels and modules

#### Requirements

Students must take a minimum of 240 Credits in Linguistics over the period of their studies

#### Structure

##### Year 1 – Level 4

Compulsory Module **Foundations of Linguistics**

Compulsory Module **Sounds of English**

Compulsory Module **Language in the UK**

Compulsory Module **Languages of the World**

Compulsory Module **Introduction to Phonology**

Compulsory Module **Introduction to English Syntax**

Compulsory Module **Introduction to Sociolinguistic Variation**

Compulsory Module **English in Use**

##### Progression Requirements to Year 2

To successfully progress from Year 1 to Year 2 students must pass a minimum of 90 credits

##### Year 2 – Level 5

45 Credits Compulsory Modules to be chosen from the following 15 Credit modules:

- **Aspects of Meaning**
- **Explaining Grammatical Structure**
- **Language Variation and Change**
- **History of English**

Minimum **15** Credits / Maximum **75** Credits optional modules to be chosen from LIN-coded modules at Level 5.

Minimum **0** Credits / Maximum **60** Credits optional modules to be chosen from all modules offered in the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film, or the Faculty of Arts subject to space available on modules with the guidance of the students' adviser. Maximum 30 credits may be at level 4 or level 6 with the advisers' agreement.

##### Progression Requirements to Final Year

To successfully progress to the Final Year students must pass a minimum of 180 credits from their first and second years.

##### Final Year – Level 6

15 Credits Compulsory Module **Research Methods in Linguistics**

30 Credits Compulsory Module **Linguistics Research Project**

Minimum **15** Credits / Maximum **75** Credits optional modules to be chosen from LIN-coded modules at Level 6.

Minimum **0** Credits / Maximum **60** Credits optional modules to be chosen from all modules offered in the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film, or the Faculty of Arts subject to space available on modules with the guidance of the students' adviser. Maximum 30 credits may be at level 5 or level 6 with the advisers' agreement.

Students are not allowed to take level 4 modules in their final year

**Requirements for Award**

Students must pass a minimum of 270 credits
