

## QQ21 Comparative Literature and Linguistics (entry 2009-10 onwards)

NB: 2008-09 entry requirements are identical for second and final year. The first requirement was 45 Credits level 4 Linguistics modules made up of the compulsory 30 Credit Foundations of Linguistics and a 15 Credit optional module.

### Programme structure(s) and requirements, levels and modules

#### Requirements

Students must take a minimum of 135 Credits in Linguistics and 135 Credits in Comparative Literature over the period of their studies.

#### Structure

##### Year 1

15 Credits compulsory module **Introduction to Literature: Texts and Contexts**

15 Credits compulsory module **Introduction to Comparison**

15 Credits compulsory module **The Scene of Teaching**

Minimum **15 Credits** / Maximum **30 Credits** optional module to be chosen from COM- / SML-coded modules at level 4.

15 Credits compulsory module **Foundations of Linguistics**

Minimum **30 Credits** / Maximum **45 Credits** optional modules to be chosen from LIN-coded modules at level 4.

Minimum **0 Credits** / Maximum **15 Credits** optional modules to be chosen all modules offered in the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film and the Faculty of Arts subject to space available on modules with the guidance of the students' adviser, at level 4.

##### Progression Requirements to Year 2

To successfully progress from Year 1 to Year 2 students must pass a minimum of 90 credits.

##### Year 2

15 Credits compulsory module **The Scene of Reading**

Minimum **15 Credits** / Maximum **60 credits** optional modules at level 5 to be chosen from COM- / SML-coded modules

Minimum **0 Credits** / Maximum **30 credits** optional module to be chosen from the list provided by the department of Comparative Literature at level 5, subject to space.

Minimum **45 Credits** / Maximum **90 Credits** optional modules at level 5 to be chosen from LIN-coded modules

Minimum **0 Credits** / Maximum **45 Credits** optional modules to be chosen all modules offered in the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film and the Faculty of Arts subject to space available on modules with the guidance of the students' adviser. Up to **30 Credits** may be at level 4 or 6.

##### Progression Requirements to Final Year

To successfully progress to the Final Year students must pass a minimum of 180 credits from their first and second years.

##### Final Year

15 Credits compulsory module **The Scene of Writing**

Minimum **30 Credits** / Maximum **60 Credits** optional modules to be chosen from COM-/SML-coded modules at level 6.

Minimum **0 Credits** / Maximum **30 Credits** optional module to be chosen from the list

provided by the department of Comparative Literature at level 6.

Minimum **45** Credits / Maximum **75** Credits optional modules to be chosen from LIN-coded modules at level 6.

Minimum **0** credits / maximum **30** credits optional module to be chosen all modules offered in the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film and the Faculty of Arts subject to space available on modules with the guidance of the students' adviser. These modules may be at level 5 or 6.

Students may not take level 4 modules in final year.

**Requirements for Award**

Students must pass a minimum of 270 Credits.
